A little way out of the city on the road to the ski slopes of Sierra Nevada (so needs a taxi ride). This is a large, attractive, elegant establishment with several agreeable dining rooms of different sizes. Serving mainly classic cuisine with some local dishes, the Ruta del Veleta has long been the top-rated address in Granada primarily for locals celebrating or enjoying special meals.

Probably the best-known and specialized in highest-rated fish and seafood restaurant in Granada, Cunini has a pleasant, wood-panelled pastel decor. The choice and presentation of fish is superlative and for which reason it could claim to be the best restaurant Granada. In summer the tables outside are an obvious attraction.

In a quiet back street of the Realejo Quarter and not far from the lovely square of Campo del Príncipe, this restaurant offers a creative and yet traditional weekly tasting menu of fresh ingredients from around Spain, principally Andalucía (e.g., the excellent red tuna), with the option of pairing with wines selected from a good wine list. The small dining room is intimate and relaxing.
