15-September

All five of us arrive Ljubljana at 17:45 on Adria flight #113 from Frankfurt. Transfer to the Grand Hotel Toplice in Lake Bled

16-September

We plan to take it easy in Lake Bled. In the afternoon we *might* want to hike Vintgar Gorge depending how everyone feels

17-September

Tour the Julian Alps. I trust your judgment as to where we go.

18-September

Drive to Ljubljana. I have booked Maja Llov for four hours beginning at 10:00 to show us around the city. If you can arrange for us to meet your cousin Jakov while we are in town, that would be great.

Continue on to the Monte Mulini Hotel in Rovinj.

19-September

We plan to spend the morning in Rovinj.

Leave for Pula around 13:00. I have booked Ljerka Mikić for three hours beginning at 14:00 to show us around.

20-September
