### Parades - MK

Afternoon parades start in Frontierland, evening start in the front of the park (15-20 min till reaches back).

**WDW Railroad's** at the Town Square end of Main Street but only a few seats.

A pathway runs along the **Liberty Square** side of the moat from the Sleepy Hollow Sandwich Shop to Cinderella's Castle. Any point along this path allows a clear view as it passes over the Liberty Square Bridge.

There is a covered walkway connecting **Liberty Tree Tavern** with *the Diamond Horseshoe Saloon*. This elevated vantage point is perfect and usually goes unnoticed till just before the parade starts.

There are elevated wooden platforms in front of the **Shootin Gallery, Trading Post** and in front of the building with the sign "**Frontier Merchandise**".

Sit on a stone wall opposite **Liberty Tree Tavern**. Saw everything because we were high and also had the option to stand on the wall.

*Sleepy Hollow Sandwich Shop* in **Liberty Square**, offers a good view of the parade from the rail-side tables on the outdoor patio.

Our favorite parade watching spot is in Frontierland in front of **the Mile Long Bar**. There's a tree and a hitching post and enough room behind the rope for a single file of our family..

### Parade - MGM

Afternoon parade starts at Star Tours.

### Fireworks - MK

Terrace of the Plaza Pavilion restaurant in Tomorrow Land.

Near the hub on the right hand side, on the walkway that leads to Tomorrowland.

Get right up next to the railing near the Mickey and someone (Donald or Minnie I think) topiary. Got some grapes from Cosmic Rays.

Look for **Tinker Bell** to fly from the rightmost turret of the castle to Timekeeper. Also view at Toontown as a second choice.

### Restaurants

*Sleepy Hollow Sandwich Shop* in Liberty Square, which is all veggie (PBJ). *Cosmic Ray's* in Tomorrowland has vegan burgers. Talking Trashcans. *El Pirata Y el Perico* in Adventureland or Mexican fast food.

#### **EPCOT-FW**

*Fountain View Espresso & Bakery* in Innovations West for pastry.

*Pasta Piazza* for a slice of pizza for about \$2.

*Coral Reef* might have a vegetarian entree. "*Just Chocolate*" dessert. (L, D)

*Garden Grill (MKC)* has pasta primavera. Go for atmosphere. (D)

Save up to 30% by asking which **WS** have *Early Evening Value Meals*(4-6)

*Canada* for caramel apples and beaver tails.

*America* for Funnel cakes

*Kringla Bakeri* in Norway for coffee and pastries.

*Boulangeri Patisserie* in France for coffee & pastry.

*Chefs de France* (expensive) and *Au Petit Cafe* (moderate).

*Japan* has a fast-food type counter in the back left of the country.

*Rose & Crown* in UK has vegetable curry. (Illum, D)

*Biergarten* in Germany (MKC)

*Mexico Cafe* (Illum, D)

*Hollywood Brown Derby* (MKC) (L, D)

#### **BOARDWALK**

### Illuminations

Generally anyplace that you have an unobstructed view of the ball in the middle of the lake, and at least 2 adjacent barges, the viewing will be nice. You may also want to be aware of the proximity of a speaker or two (which are spaced around the walk) so you will get good audio.

Sulfur smell can blow in your face in waves of fog; be sure to sit with the wind blowing from behind you. Check out the way the flags blow.

Sit on the promenade between Norway and Mexico on around through Canada, UK and the bridge promenade by France. Or on the promenade between Germany and China.

Sitting on the edge (top level) of a *little fountain* between the USA and Italy.

On the *International Gateway Island*.

The *Gondola Landing* at Italy is excellent.

The *Boat Dock* opposite Germany is very good.

Sit on tiered area by the water in front of France. Sit at America (12:00) or UK (3:00) or FutureWorld (6:00) or Norway (9:00).

Sit in small "park" just north of England.

Rose and Crown - There is **free seating** outside the Rose and Crown along the rail with small tables that did not fill up until 8:15.

We favor the little spot just to the left of Germany (as you face Germany). It is a great little spot that has a surprise during the show.

**Secret garden** -Take the path running down the side of the Rose & Crown Pub (stay on the sidewalk and bear left) on the French side. There's a nice little sitting area there right by the lagoon.

Watch from **Cantina de San Angel**. This is the best spot but might need to get there 1 hour early.

**Great Movie Ride:** If queue outside too long. Left for gangsters; right for western.  
**Star Tours:** Rear seats.  
**MuppetVision 4D:** Wait by left doors; middle row. Hidden meanings in props  
 (A net full of Jello = Annette Funicello)  
**Indiana Jones:** 2nd show. 20-30 min early. Rear, right seats.  
**Magic of Disney Animation Tour:** Do during weekday when working.  
**Backlot Tour (Tram):** Left side.

**ABC Sound Studio:** 3-D sound demo booth  
**Superstar Television:** No front rows.

**It's a Wonderful Shop:** By Mama Melroses. and Muppetvision for personalized ornaments  
**Boats:** Swan/Dolphin is the last stop before heading to MGM, and first stop back.  
**Parade route:** Less crowded near Star Tours.  
**Guest Services:** Left as you enter; Live entertainment schedules.  
**Tip Board:** At end of Hollywood Blvd.  
**Singing in the Rain umbrella:** Attached to a streetlight near the Hunchback theater. Grab the umbrella and step on the black square.

**Blizzard Beach**

**Slush Gusher & Teamboat Springs:** Front right of the mountain  
**Rapids:** Back side of the mountain  
**Summit Plummet :** 120 foot high ski jump at speeds of 60-mph.  
**Slush Gusher:** 90 foot high double-humped slide.  
**Toboggan Racer:** Head-first eight lane race course.

**Snow Stormers:** Fumes that race down the mountain through slalom gates.  
**Teamboat Springs:** White-water raft ride. Up to six passengers.  
**Cross Country Creek:** Lazy tube ride around the park.  
**Downhill Double Dipper:** Side-by-side tube race.  
**Runoff Rapids:** 3 high-speed tube-raft slides. Center (best) is enclosed and must ride solo; two outer slides can be ridden on 1,2 or 3 person rafts.  
**Ski Patrol Training Camp** is designed for pre-teens.

**Picnic spots:** Hard to find. Claim a picnic table or an umbrella lounge chair.  
**Locker rentals:** Snowless Joe's Rental.  
**Restrooms:** Near the Warming Hut are the least crowded.  
**Beach of the surf pool:** Best location for a breeze.

**River Country**

**Bay Cove:** 'Ol Swimmin' Hole theme: rope swings, T-Bars, large platforms.  
**Whoop-'N-Holler Hollow:** 2 water slides  
**Upstream Plunge:** Swimming pool and Slippery Slide Falls (water slides).  
**Beach Area/Mini-Bay Cove:** Tamer version of Bay Cove (better suited to younger children). There is a grassy area with picnic tables.  
**Nature Trail:** Located along the shore of Bay Lake.

Access by car is a hassle. Take a boat from the GF(?).

**Comedy Warehouse** - for a good laugh sit next to the telephones!

**Adventurers Club** - The AC's doors open at 7PM. The first activity is usually scheduled for 7:20 and last starts about 12:50. Upon arrival, simply proceed to the Main Salon and wait for the next activity to begin. After each event, return to the Main Salon and wait for next one to be announced. After Library events,

guests exit through a back door which opens onto a corridor and a door that exits outside. Most guests assume that the show is all over and take the hint, thinking that they have to leave. This is not the case--simple turn left into the corridor upon exiting the Library and return to the Main Salon.

The stools at the Main Salon bar can be made to slowly rise or fall at the whim of the bartender.

The illuminated ship-in-the-bottle that is displayed on the wall behind the Library bar doesn't always just sit there looking pretty. Keep an eye on it after the storm.
