PERU

BRAZIL

Most services in Brazil include a service charge of 10%. An additional gratuity is appropriate if the staff has performed a special service for you. Because of high unemployment, services that may seem superfluous are customarily tipped. Parking assistants are the most notable, as they receive no wages, and gas station attendants, shoe shiners, and barbers frequently are tipped.

Restaurants: 10% if gratuity is not included in the bill

* Dining with Your Guide

While touring with your guide, you are typically given the opportunity to choose from restaurant menus and to pay on the spot. This is also an opportunity to either have a break from the guiding or to continue learning. The choice is yours. If you

simply need assistance from your guide in selecting from a menu, just ask. After advising you, the guide will then give you time on your own. If you invite your guide to join you for lunch, it is customary for you to pay for your guide's meal.

Cancellations

Cancellations must be made in writing and received by R. Crusoe & Son. Cancellations received 90 days or more prior to departure are subject to a \$300 per person/per tour cancellation fee. Cancellations received less than 90 days prior to departure are subject to the following forfeit as a percentage of tour cost: 89-60 days, 10 percent of tour cost; 59-30 days, 35 percent of tour cost; 29 days or less, 100 percent of tour cost.
